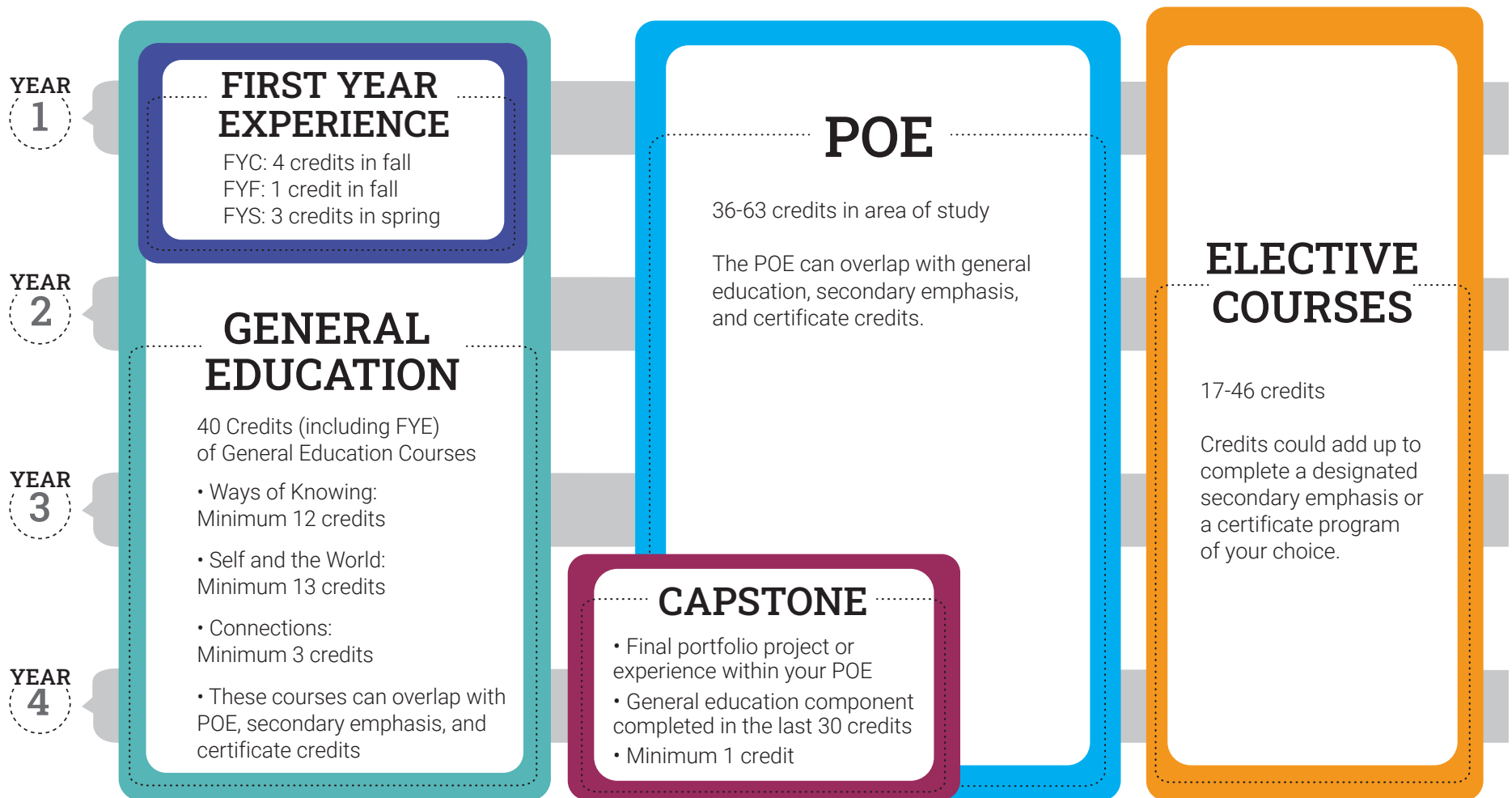

YEAR
1

WAYS OF KNOWING

Minimum 12 credits

- Creative Expression
- Formal Reasoning
- Humanistic Thought
- Scientific Process
- Social Inquiry

Keep in mind:

- Students can waive one closely related to POE
- Each must be taken from a different department prefix
- Students must complete at least 2 by the end of Sophomore year

FIRST YEAR EXPERIENCE

First Year Composition (FYC):
• 4 credits in fall

First Year Seminar (FYS):
• 3 credits in spring

First Year Foundations (FYF):
• 1 credit in fall

First Year Foundations, Composition, and Seminar are courses with engaging themes that help you develop written and oral communication skills and provide an introduction to Juniata and the liberal arts.

SELF AND THE WORLD

Minimum 13 credits

- Ethical Responsibility
- Global Engagement (2 courses)
- Local Engagement
- U.S. Experience

Keep in mind:

- Students fulfill Global Engagement for Juniata-approved study abroad for a semester or year
- Students can waive one Ways of Knowing (WK) for a semester abroad and waive one additional Self and the World (SW) for a year

Minimum 3 credits

An interdisciplinary course taught by two or more instructors from two different ways of knowing.

Minimum 1 credit

- Project or Internship
- General education component
